Did you Know?

Since 2001, communities across Alabama have made a huge impact through tiny pop tabs! Schools, families, and businesses alike collect pop tabs throughout the year and donate them to our House. Ronald McDonald House Charities of Alabama (RMHCA) partners with Brother's Recycling in Birmingham, A&S Metals in Decatur, SA Recycling in Sheffield, and Capital Recycling in Montgomery to receive funds based on the going rate per pounds of aluminum recycled. These funds are used to support operations at the House.

You can Help!

1. **Pull those tabs!** Save the aluminum tabs from your soda cans, vegetable and soup cans.
2. **Save them for the House** in wide-mouthed containers like shoe boxes or ziplock bags.
3. **Recruit your friends!** Get your school, community, workplace, or church involved too.
4. **Recycle Your Tabs.** Bring them to RMHCA at 1700 4th Ave S. Birmingham, AL 35205, drop off at one of our Recycling Partners (be sure to let them know the collection is for RMHCA), or you can mail them to us.
