The Ronald McDonald House, cares for up to 73 guest families every night, keeping them together while their children receive medical treatment. In addition to providing a comfortable bedroom, we surround our families with love and support from our volunteers, staff and other guest families who share the same hopes and fears.

In addition, we provide a comfortable, relaxing place to rest and regroup while only steps away from a sick child's bedside at our Ronald McDonald Family Room at DCH Regional Medical Center in Tuscaloosa and the new Ronald McDonald Family Room at UAB Women & Infants Center in Birmingham. We also have a Happy Wheels Cart that delivers the comfort and care provided by the Ronald McDonald House to children and families while they're at Children's of Alabama.
